Dear Mr. Filippo Grandi,

I am Seyamak Naderi. I was receiving monthly allowance from UNHCR (in Albania) in 2015. In 2016, UNHCR paid us the allowance for the first three months of 2016 (till the end of March in one payment) and informed us that they will not pay any more allowance.

I have quit PMOI and do not want to be chained in scandalous, shameful and slavish system of this organization. This is my natural right not to accept their hegemony and control in my life. But apart from all these, my main issue is not PMOI's hegemony and dominance. I have been imprisoned in PMOI and have been tortured physically and mentally so many times and finally they plotted and executed a plan to kill me. I have given you the report about these issues while I was in PMOI and that was the reason I told Mr. Rafie (the interpreter of Mr. Nicola Bacci, the head of UNHCR in Albania), that I do not have any source of income and not authorized to work in Albania. I also emphasized that I do not get any allowance or money from PMOI and will never get. I told Mr. Rafi in person that even if I die from hunger will not get anything from PMOI.

In reply to my email, Mr. Spiros Coutroubas has informed that this decision is made by UNHCR's Local office in Tirana. We all know that UNCHR's system is like a network and Local office in Albania cannot make decision outside scope of UNHCR Headquarters in Geneva therefore they should not shirk their responsibility.

I would appreciate if you kindly look into this matter and support me as per UNHCR regulations.

Please consider this email as confidential, since I have written it to you, Mr. Turk and Mr. Spiros Coutroubas.

Thank you in advance for your kind and crucial support at this tough time.
